

TAX TREATY REPRESENTATION LETTER

FOR STUDENT EMPLOYEES

Peoples Republic of China (Article 20(c))

1. I was a resident of Peoples Republic of China on the date of my arrival in the United States. I am not a U.S. citizen. I have not been lawfully accorded the privilege of residing permanently in the U.S. as an immigrant.
2. I am temporarily present in the United States for the primary purpose of studying at the **University of Maryland**.
3. I will receive compensation for personal services performed in the United States. This compensation qualifies for exemption from withholding of federal income tax under the tax treaty between the United States and Peoples Republic of China in an amount not in excess of \$5,000 for any taxable year. I have not previously claimed an income tax exemption under this treaty for income received as a teacher, researcher, or student before the date of my arrival in the United States.
4. I arrived in the United States on _____ (the date of your last arrival in the United States before beginning study or training). I am claiming this exemption only for such period of time as is reasonably necessary to complete the education or training.
